Pocket Chart Graph

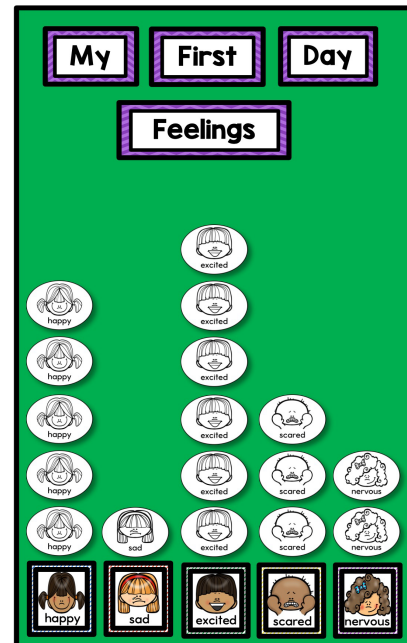

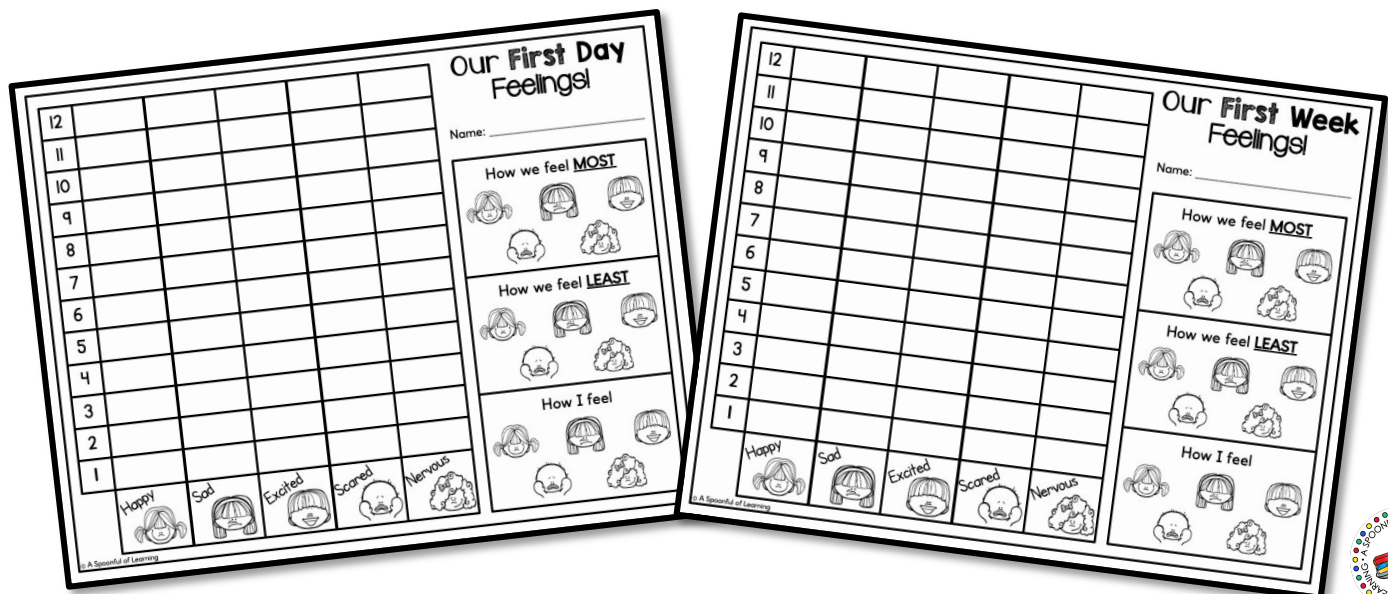

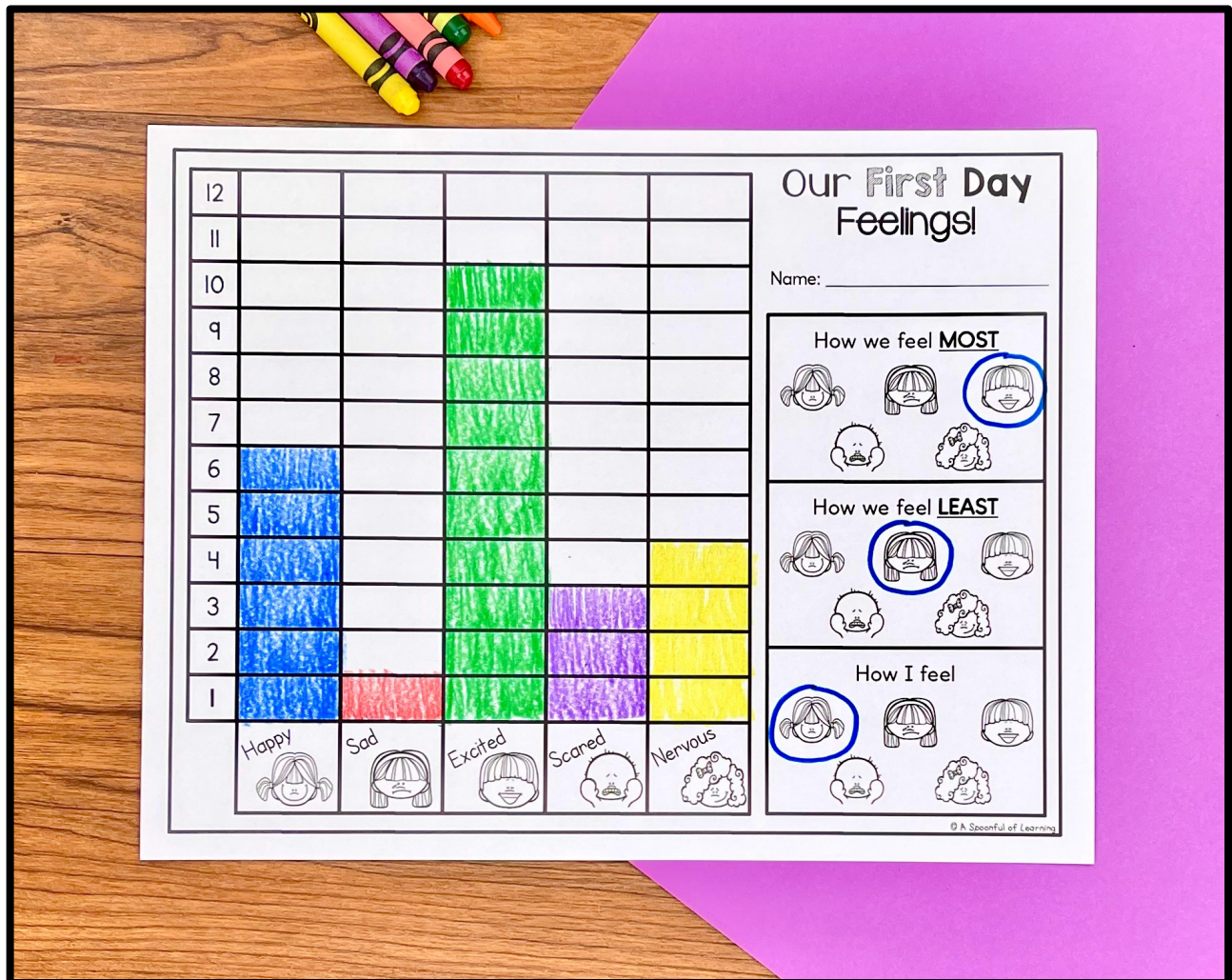
