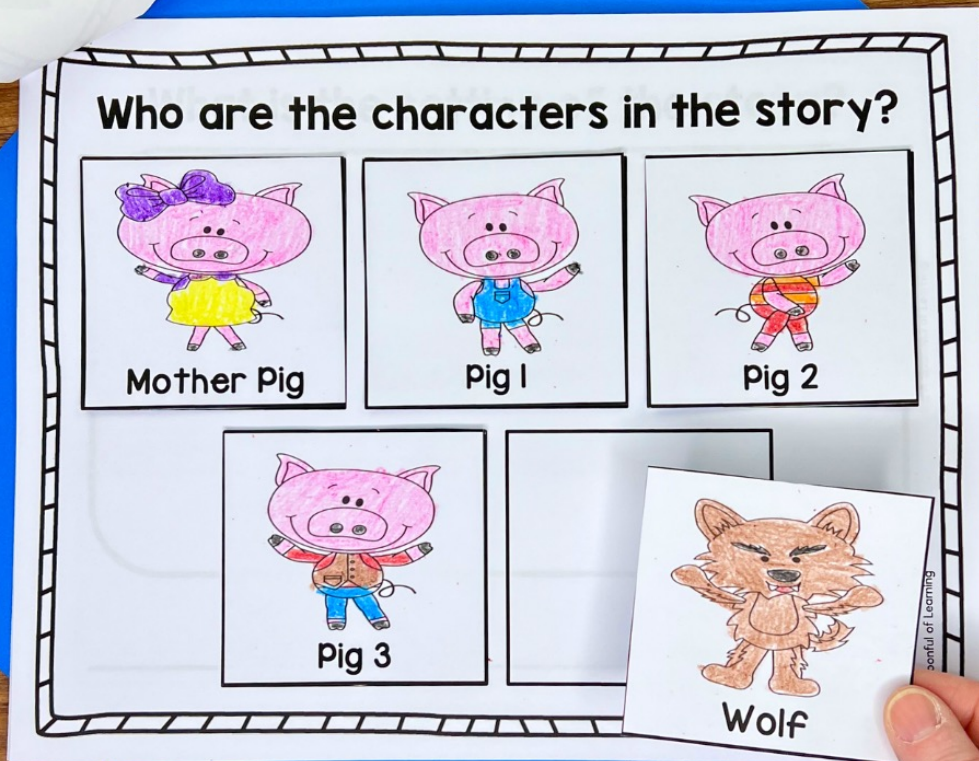

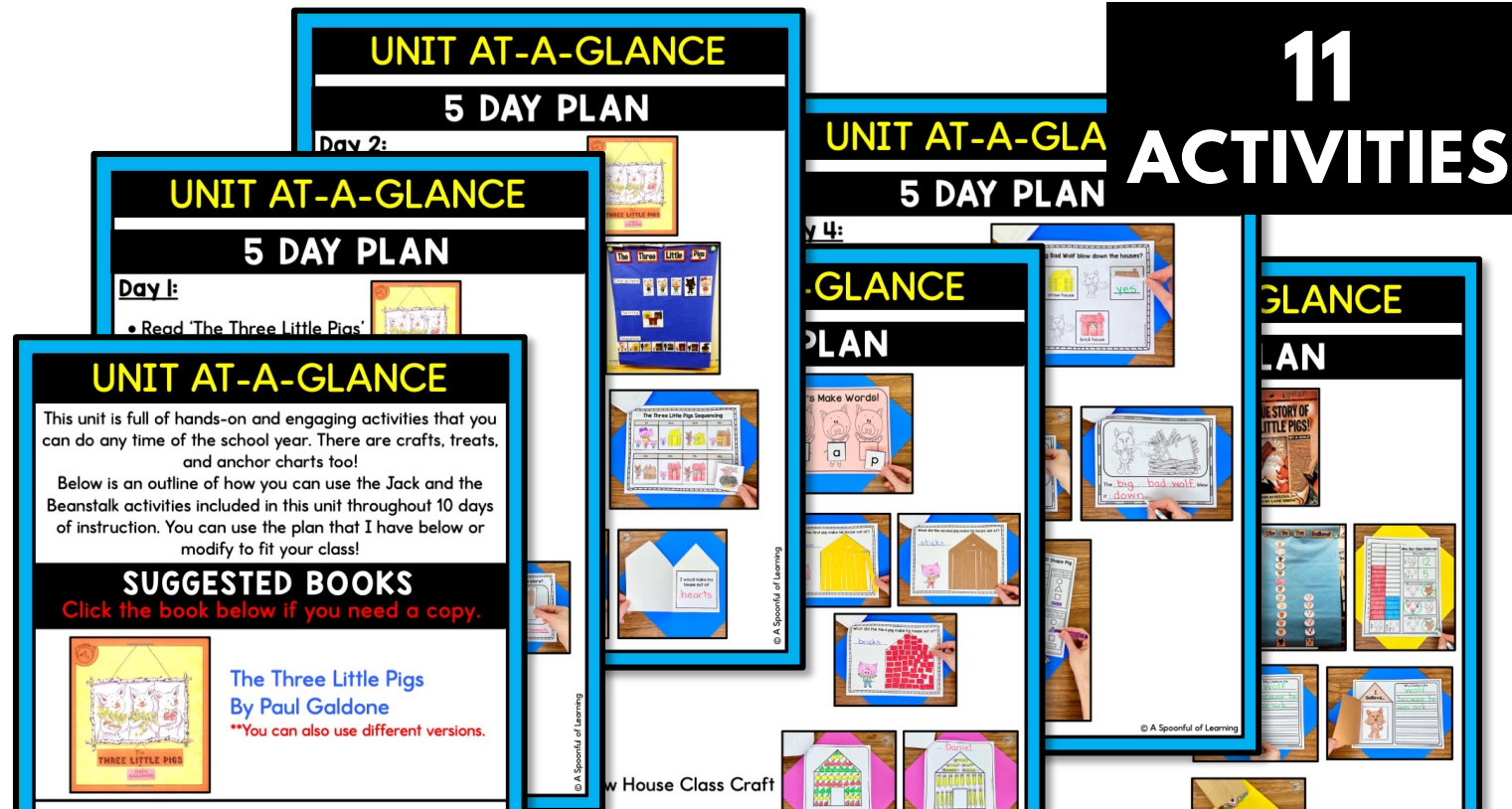

Dive deep into the story and learn about the different story elements. This interactive student book focuses on the characters, setting, sequencing, and comprehension.

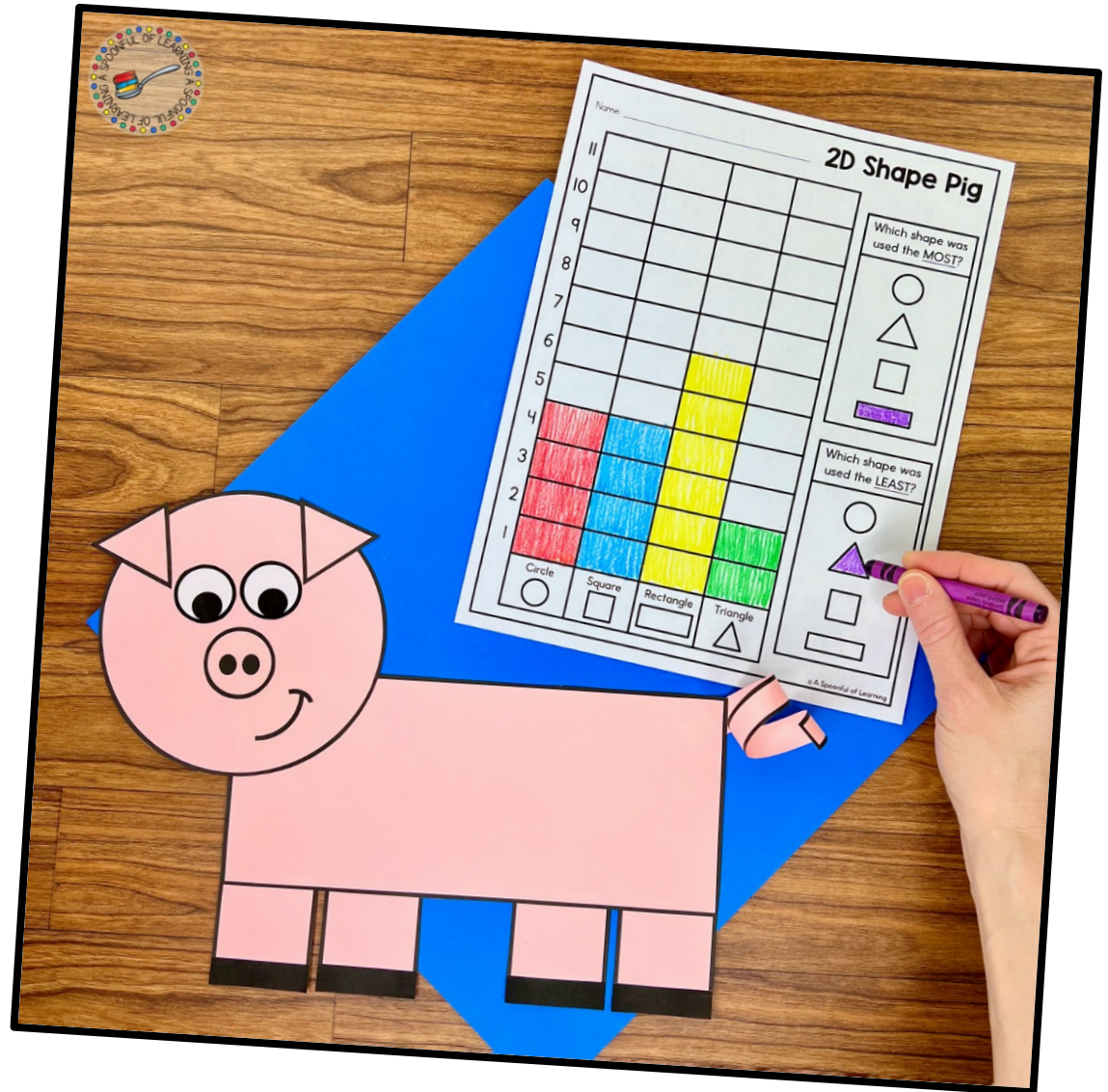


THREE LITTLE PIGS

Show how many you used of each shape by filling in a graph.

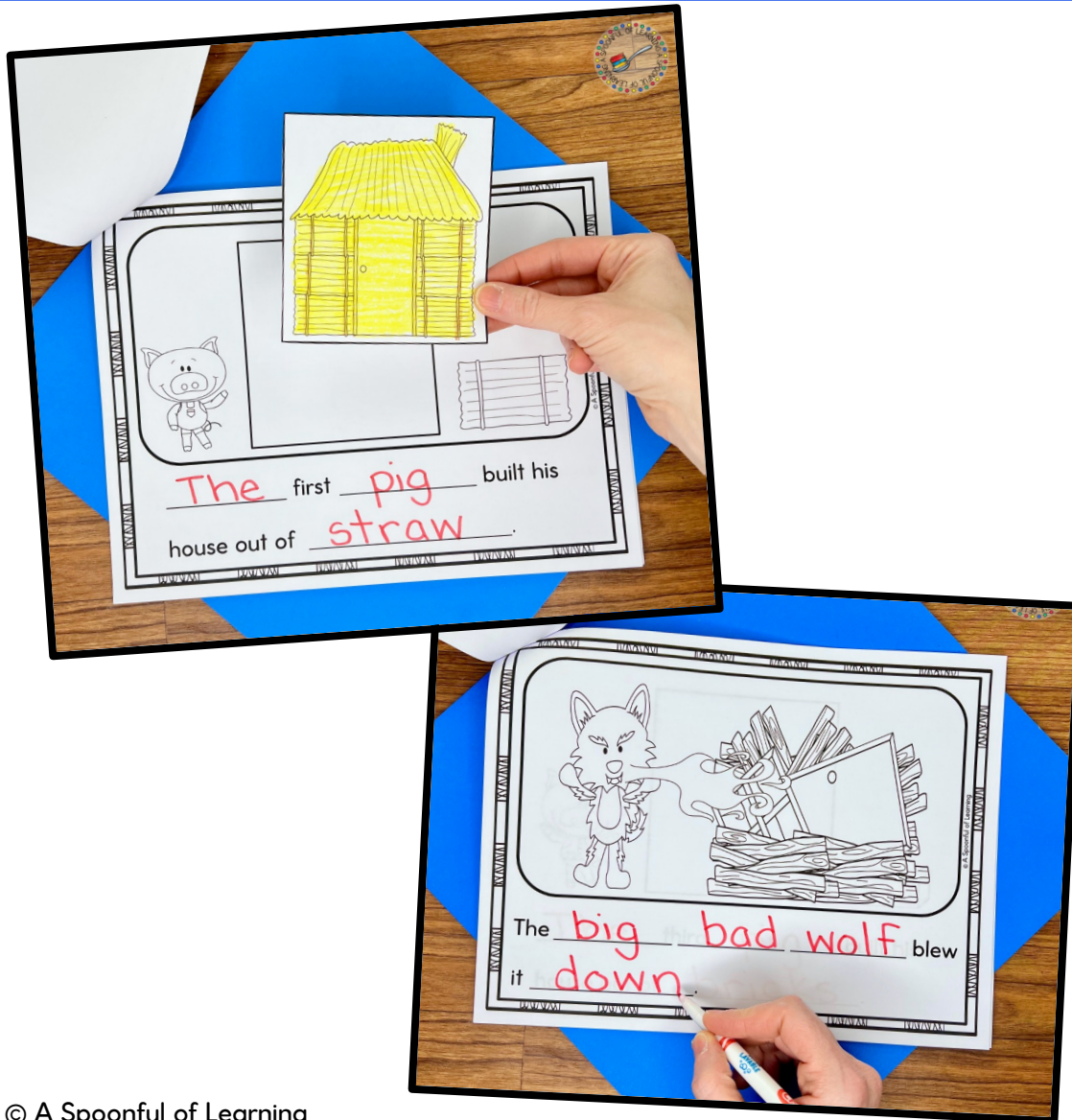


THREE LITTLE PIGS

WHO DO YOU BELIEVE GRAPH

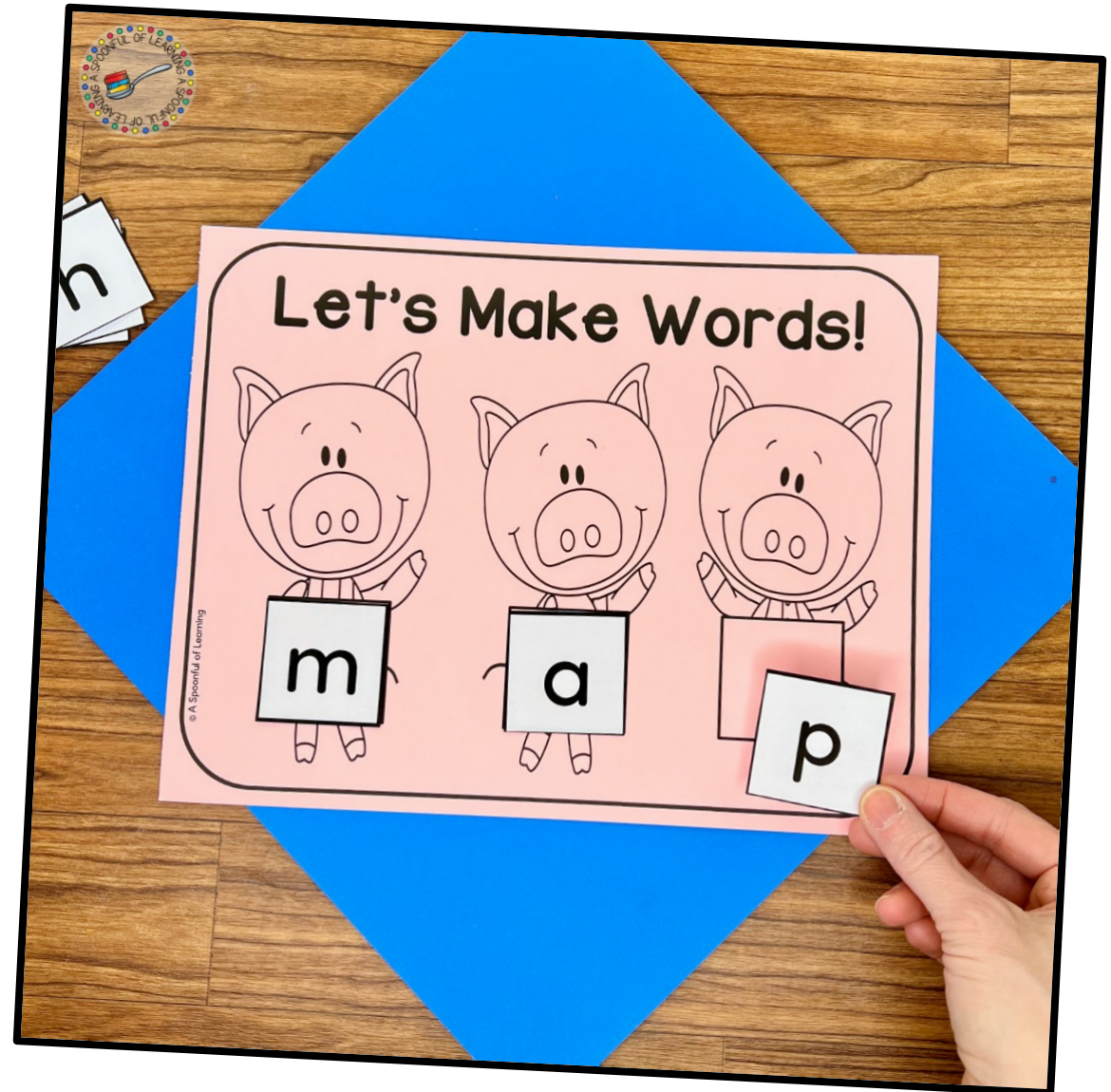
Create a class graph on whether they believe the three little pigs or the wolf. Fill in a graph and data to show the results of the class graph.

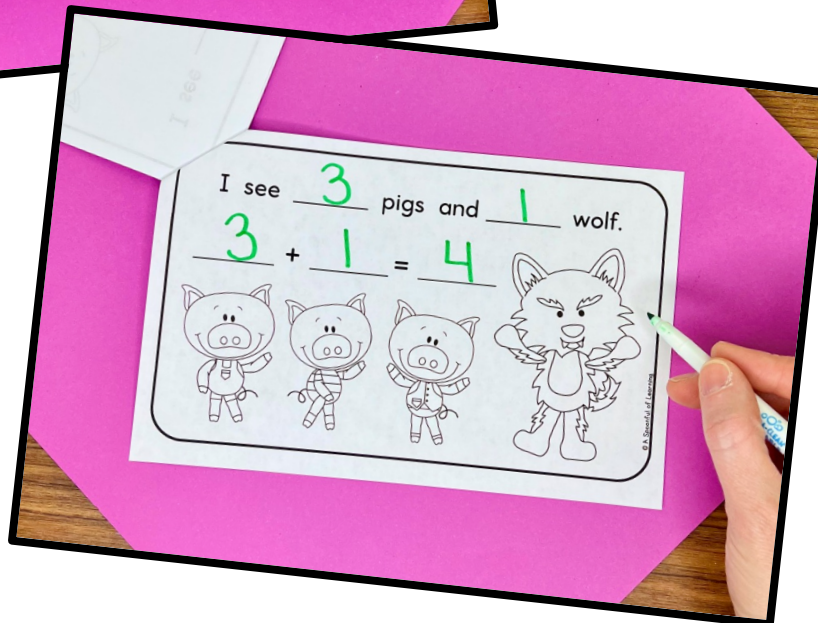
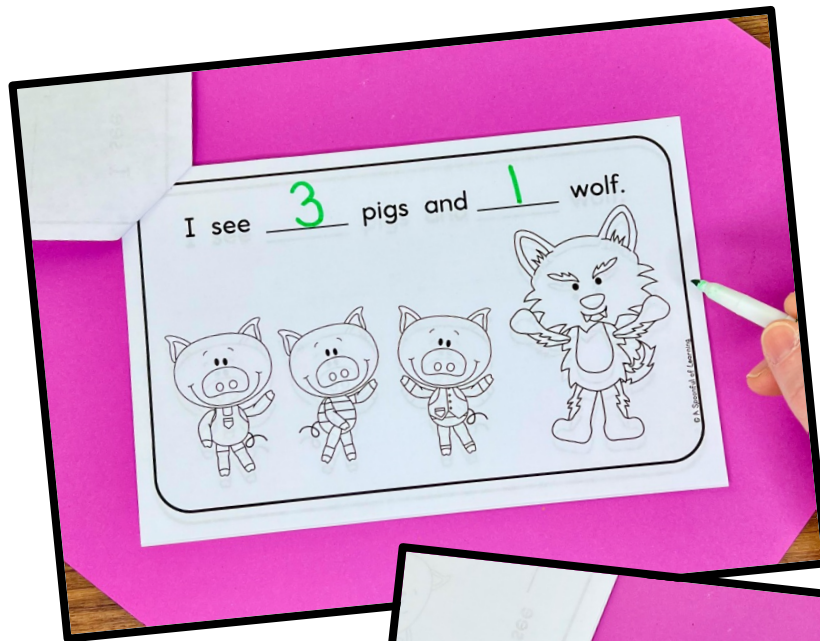

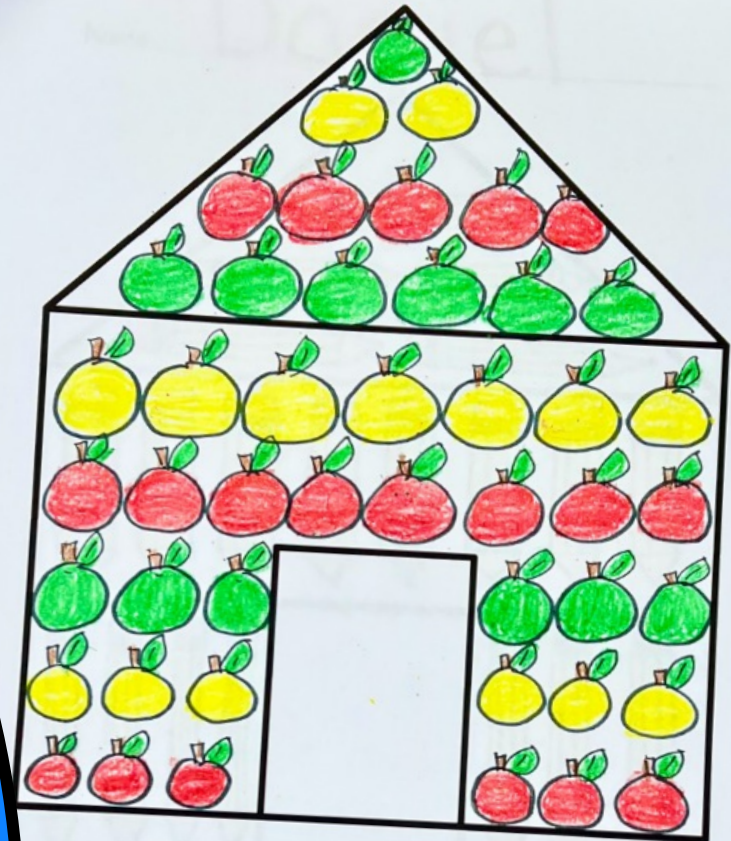
